Job Description: The agriculture advisor will establish and maintain a team of students that are interested in learning more about sustainable agriculture. The agriculture advisor will handle all the logistics necessary to ensure the successful completion of the adopted West Virginia agriculture standard and curriculum.

The agriculture advisor will contribute to the grant writing process for acquisitions of agriculture equipment, materials, and facilities. The agriculture advisor will need to fundraise for money that is needed to cover costs.

Qualifications: Holds a West Virginia Teaching License. Background agriculture is required or a West Virginia Agriculture Certification. Ability to effectively communicate to students the importance of conservation. Ability to teach the safeguarding of land. Ability to take the West Virginia middle school introduction to agriculture standards and adapt them to your specific school environment. Ability to teach students self-sustainability and where their food comes from. Ability to work with the district's agriculture mentor.
